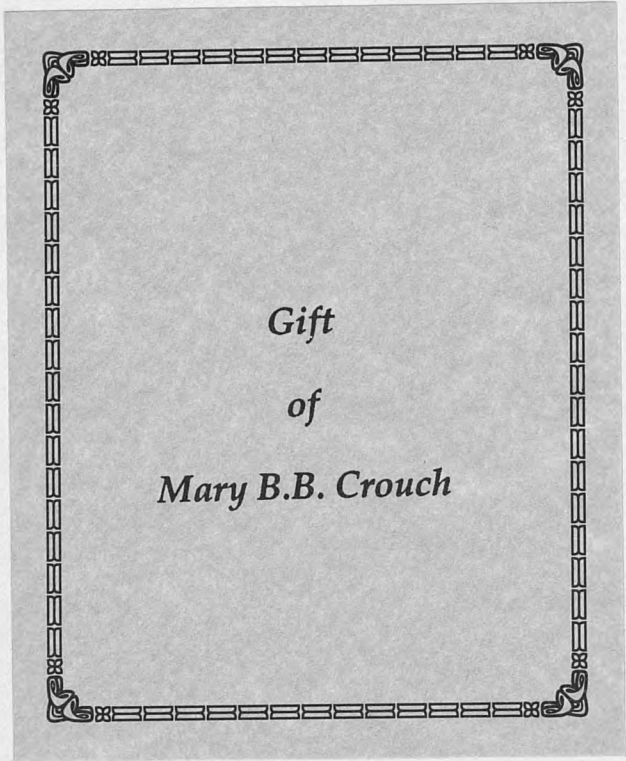

REFERENCE—NOT TO BE
TAKEN FROM THIS ROOM

In the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty Don Louis Lorimier and his associates D. F. Steinbeck, Victor Lorimier, and Thomas P. Rodney set aside six acres of land to be used then and forever after as a burying ground for the citizens of Cape Girardeau, Missouri.

"Provided always that the several tracts or parcels of land thus granted to the town of Cape Girardeau and the citizens thereof shall remain forever affected and appropriated to the public uses to which they are respectfully intended and that they nor any part of them, shall ever become private property."

This beautiful site over-looking the majestic Mississippi River became the final resting place of many of the pioneer citizens of this community.

In the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and forty-three and forty-four a band of loyal members of the Nancy Hunter Chapter, Daughters of the American Revolution, under the leadership of the regent Uline Fenwick Potashnick, copied the inscriptions on these grave stones--inscriptions fast being obliterated by time and the elements.

These records have been tabulated and compiled in book form in order that these names, dates of births and deaths may not pass into oblivion as if they had not been.

As it ever has been the policy of the Daughters of the American Revolution to perpetuate the early history of our nation, the Nancy Hunter Chapter expresses the wish that it has, in some small measure, preserved for future generations this historical data found on the markers in old Lorimier Cemetery and herein recorded.
